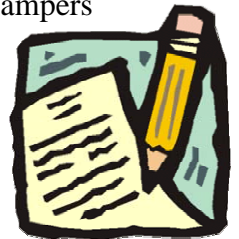

BACK TO THE TOWER..

Now that Erik and his band of merry men/women have closed-up camp after some pretty good fall weather, the machines and trucks are coming back to Adventure Island for a really BIG project!! Our gymnasium, which has served us so well for over 30 years, is going to be completely rebuilt and the design is just stunning! We are building a brand new floor from the ground up and installing a permanent fabric roof which will keep the weather out all year. The trampoline area will be expanded and will move to the other end of the gym and the placement of gym apparatus and new pits will allow for much greater use of the gym as an all camp activity area. The open air design which we have all loved from the beginning at camp will remain with special sides that are open all summer and closed for winter. All of the supporting piers and columns will be made of special concrete and pinned to bedrock by drilled steel rods so that the days of frost heaving and the damage it causes to our floor should be finally over! This is a massive project which will be totally completed 3 weeks before the opening of camp next summer - watch out for news of our grand opening ceremony during Session 1!!



Our camp office has now returned to C.A.C. World Headquarters in Thornhill but with all the work going on at camp we are travelling back and forth to Adventure Island regularly. In between ordering all the supplies needed by the crew at camp, Justin, Erik and our super bookkeeper, Doris, are busy registering lots of campers for our fantastic summer of 2008!!
