The last few weeks of work to finish our new sewage system will take place this Spring and the first piers for the roof of our incredible new Gymnasium and Trampoline Centre will be poured at the end of the season. Our old Swim Bay docks will now find new life as tubing, sailing and boat docks, etc. All this action will be a huge workload for everyone but we are very excited about it all and can't wait to get started. 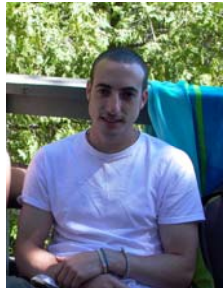

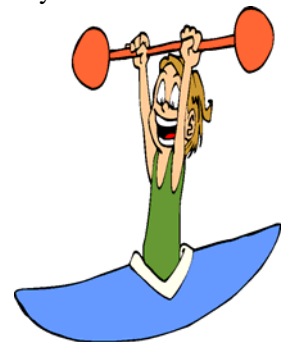

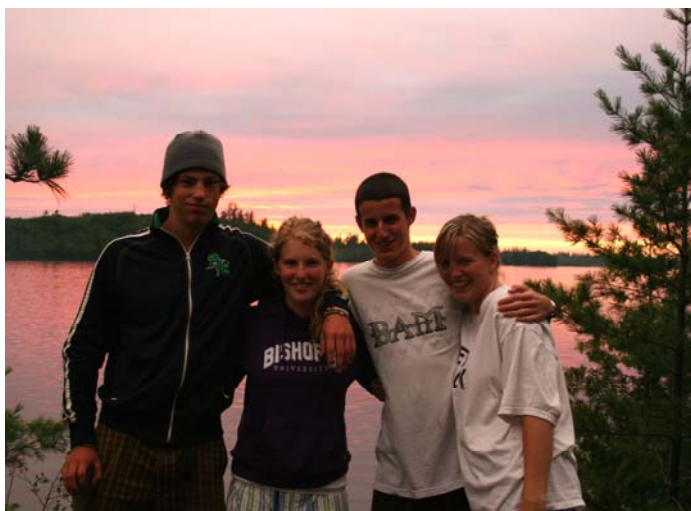
