GB's Chocolate Chip Cookies!

We know how much you like homemade cookies at camp, well why not have them at home too! Here is all the ingredients and directions you need to make them yourself! Of course we've changed the amounts, unless you want to make 200 cookies!!



Ingredients:

Brown Sugar	115g / 4oz
Sugar	115g / 4oz
Margarine	115g / 4oz
Eggs	115g / 4oz
Bread Flour	135g / 5oz
Pastry Flour	135g / 5oz
Baking Soda	1ml / 1/5 tsp
Chocolate Chips	135g / 5oz

Instructions:

Cream together the brown sugar, sugar and margarine. Add eggs and blend.
 Combine the dry ingredients together then add it to the egg / sugar
 mixture.
 Add the chocolate chips, but dont add to much!
 Scoop cookies on a lined baking sheet and press down lightly.

Cooking Instructions:

Convection Oven:	Bake at 325°F for 8-10 minutes, until golden brown.
Traditional Oven:	Bake at 375°F for 10-12 minutes, until golden brown.
