*Campers aged 10+, design their own schedule,
choosing their own activities.
Sign-up for activities happens the day before.*

*Our youngest campers (aged 5 to 9) do most
of their activities with their cabin groups*

*Activities which require more time, such as
kayaking and sailing will last 2 periods.*

*Campers in specialty programs (Gymnastics, Trampoline and Water Skiing)
will spend approximately 1/2 of each day training in their chosen program.*

*Meals are family style (not cafeteria).
Each cabin has their own round table.*

Chartered Buses from Toronto!



Campers can begin their camp fun in Toronto! Buses (washroom and video equipped) leave Yorkdale Shopping Centre, Highway 401 and Dufferin St. at 10:00am each opening Monday, stopping for lunch on the way.

Buses return at 4:30pm on closing Sundays (traffic permitting).

Pick-ups and drop-offs can be arranged for Barrie, Orillia and Gravenhurst. Some out of town parents take advantage of a weekend in Toronto and drive their camper to and from the bus.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long is the drive to Camp?

Temagami is approximately 4 ½ hours North of Toronto and 4 ½ hours Northwest of Ottawa.
